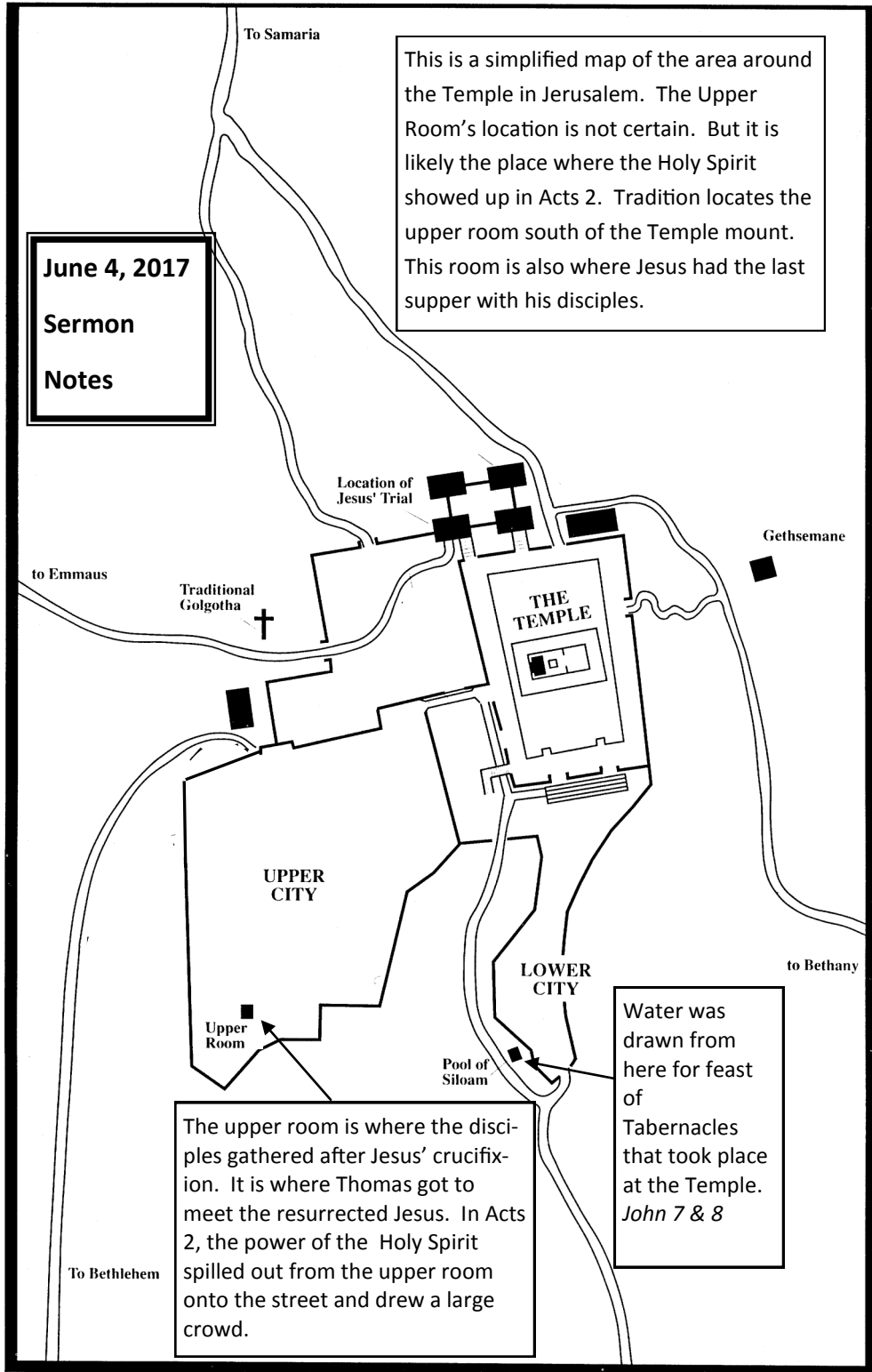

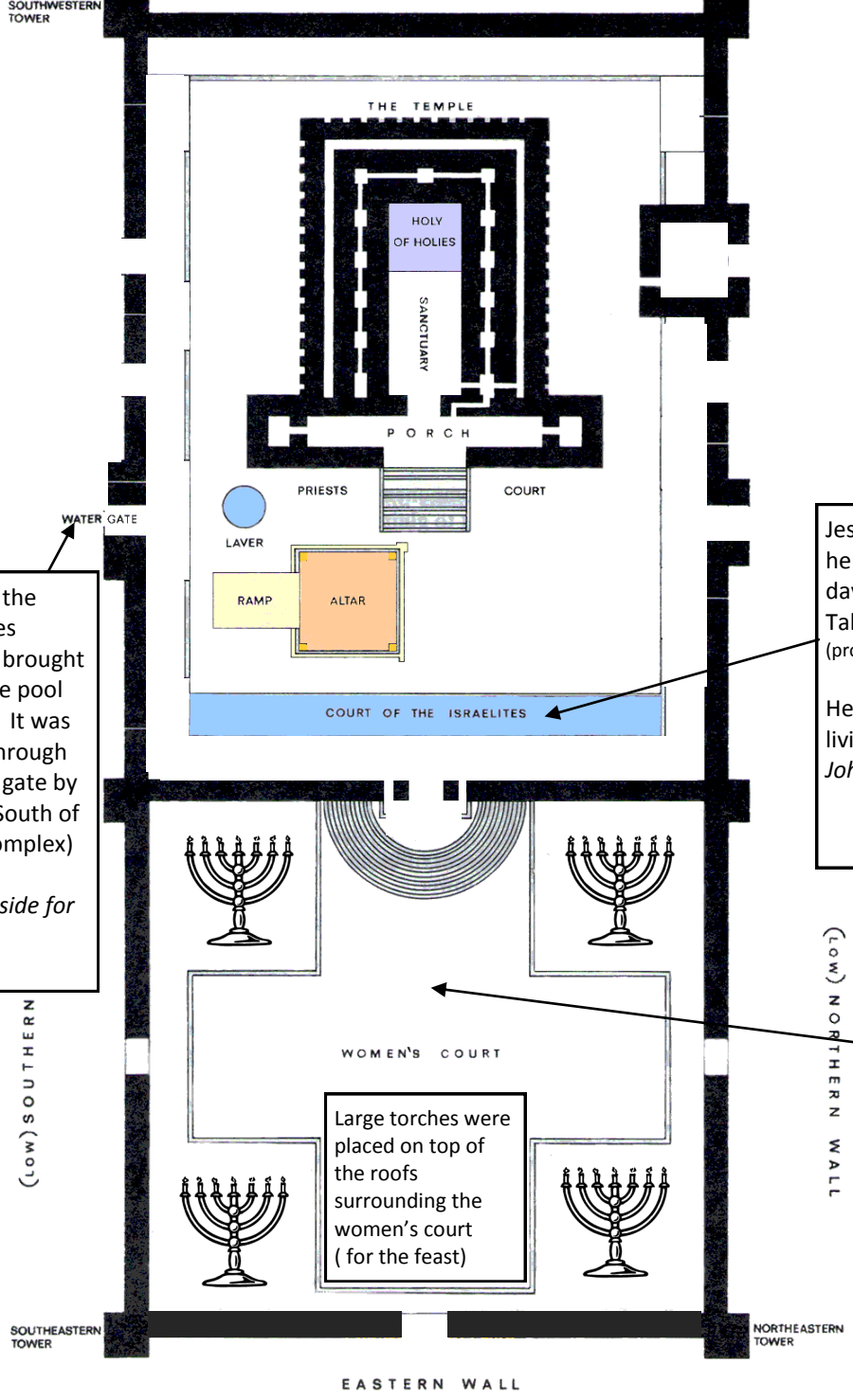
This is a simplified map of the area around the Temple in Jerusalem. The Upper Room's location is not certain. But it is likely the place where the Holy Spirit showed up in Acts 2. Tradition locates the upper room south of the Temple mount. This room is also where Jesus had the last supper with his disciples.



The upper room is where the disciples gathered after Jesus' crucifixion. It is where Thomas got to meet the resurrected Jesus. In Acts 2, the power of the Holy Spirit spilled out from the upper room onto the street and drew a large crowd.

Water was drawn from here for feast of Tabernacles that took place at the Temple. *John 7 & 8*

Simplified Inner area of the Temple in Jesus' Time



Water for the tabernacles ritual was brought in from the pool of Siloam. It was brought through the water gate by a priest. (South of Temple complex)
See other side for location.

Jesus taught here on last day of feast of Tabernacles. (probably)
 He said he was living water. *John 7*

Jesus taught here *after* the feast of tabernacles the morning After the last day of feast. He called himself the light of the world. *John 8*

Large torches were placed on top of the roofs surrounding the women's court (for the feast)
